

Emissions reduction targets

In order to achieve Net Zero by 2050 we have currently adopted a range of carbon reduction targets – these targets are under constant review in order to widen target methods.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the following five years of our commitment to 333.6 tCO₂e. This is a reduction of 38% from baseline year 2025.

Completed/Planned Carbon Reduction Initiatives

- Implementation of online system for case management and reduced reliance on paper.
- Planned replacement of windows at Head office and the boiler to improve carbon efficiency.
- Review of supply chains to move to locally sourced products
- Working with Landlords with decarbonisation programmes to ensure insulation, reducing energy demand.
- Removal of provision lease cars; public transport is encouraged.
- New developments with Partners are developed net zero carbon
- Planned installation of a bike shelter at Head office
- Waste recycling in operation at all sites
- Where possible management meetings involving personnel geographically spread carried out on Microsoft Teams
- Staff and service users reminded to reuse, recycle, reduce and recycling points/containers are clearly signposted
- We have Environmental Champions including people who use our services
- We are currently investigating registering/achieving recognised environmental management accreditation.
